**Our Mission:** To tutor, guide and inspire at-risk youth living in low income and public housing to achieve academic success.

**YTP Students:** YTP serves 445+ first through twelfth grade students each year at six tutoring centers in Seattle.

## About YTP

YTP was started in 1991 as a partnership with the Seattle Housing Authority after resident families requested academic support for their youth. YTP tutoring centers provide youth with:

- An encouraging learning environment
- Structured, individualized tutoring sessions
- Skill building activities
- Homework help

Many of our students' parents cannot help their children with schoolwork due to long hours at work, limited school experience, and limited English ability.

### 87%

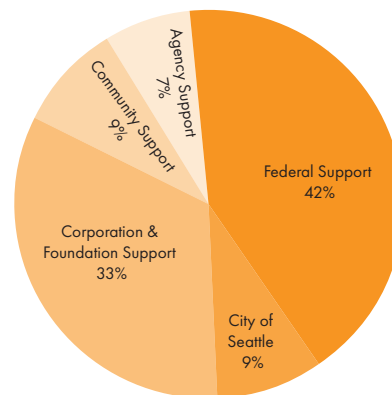
of YTP students come from immigrant and refugee families.
