HOUSING AND HOMELESS SERVICES

HOUSING SNOHOMISH

Programs and services that support homeless individuals and families, including short term financial assistance (rapid rehousing), chemical dependency and mental health services, HIV/AIDS supportive services, veterans programs, permanent supportive housing, and help with employment, healthcare and education.

CCS Recovery Centers provide a full continuum of outpatient addiction recovery services in Snohomish County for youth and adults and their families. Services are provided in both Everett and Marysville.

COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

425-257-1621

CCS provides community mental health services to Medicaid eligible children and their families. After an initial assessment and determination of need for ongoing help, core mental health services are available at CCS including individual and/or family counseling/therapy, medication evaluation/management and coordination with primary care physicians, and case management.

CHILDREN'S WRAPAROUND PROGRAMS

Services are provided to Medicaid-eligible children and their families with high mental health and other complex needs, using a team-based Wraparound approach.

LAYETTE SERVICES

425-257-2111

Provides low-income families with basic newborn necessities. Layettes include bottles, socks, one outfit, sleepers, a stuffed animal and a baby blanket.

SENIORS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

HOME CARE FOR ELDERS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

CCS provides affordable non-medical assistance to seniors and people with disabilities living in their own homes. Training for caregivers is provided in multiple languages, including English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Somali, Russian, Cantonese and Korean.

RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (RSVP)

Volunteers 55 years or older are placed at "work stations" throughout Snohomish County, according to the type of volunteer work they enjoy and skill sets they have to share, for example hospitals, food banks, and Senior Centers.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES

425-374-6303

Volunteers help elders and adults with disabilities remain independent in their own homes. Services are provided at no charge for those individuals who cannot afford to pay for assistance.

VOLUNTEER TRANSPORTATION

Provides necessary transportation for low-income elders and adults with disabilities to access medical appointments and other essential errands, such as grocery shopping. Also provides transportation to maintain social connections.

VETERANS SERVICES

DISABLED VETERANS TRANSPORTATION

Provides door-to-door services for disabled veterans living in underserved areas of Snohomish County to access medical appointments and other essential errands.

SEBASTIAN PLACE

With 20 units of permanent supportive housing, Sebastian Place provides another housing choice for chronically homeless and vulnerable Veterans that have difficulty finding and qualifying for housing in the private market, and that are seeking a supportive community.

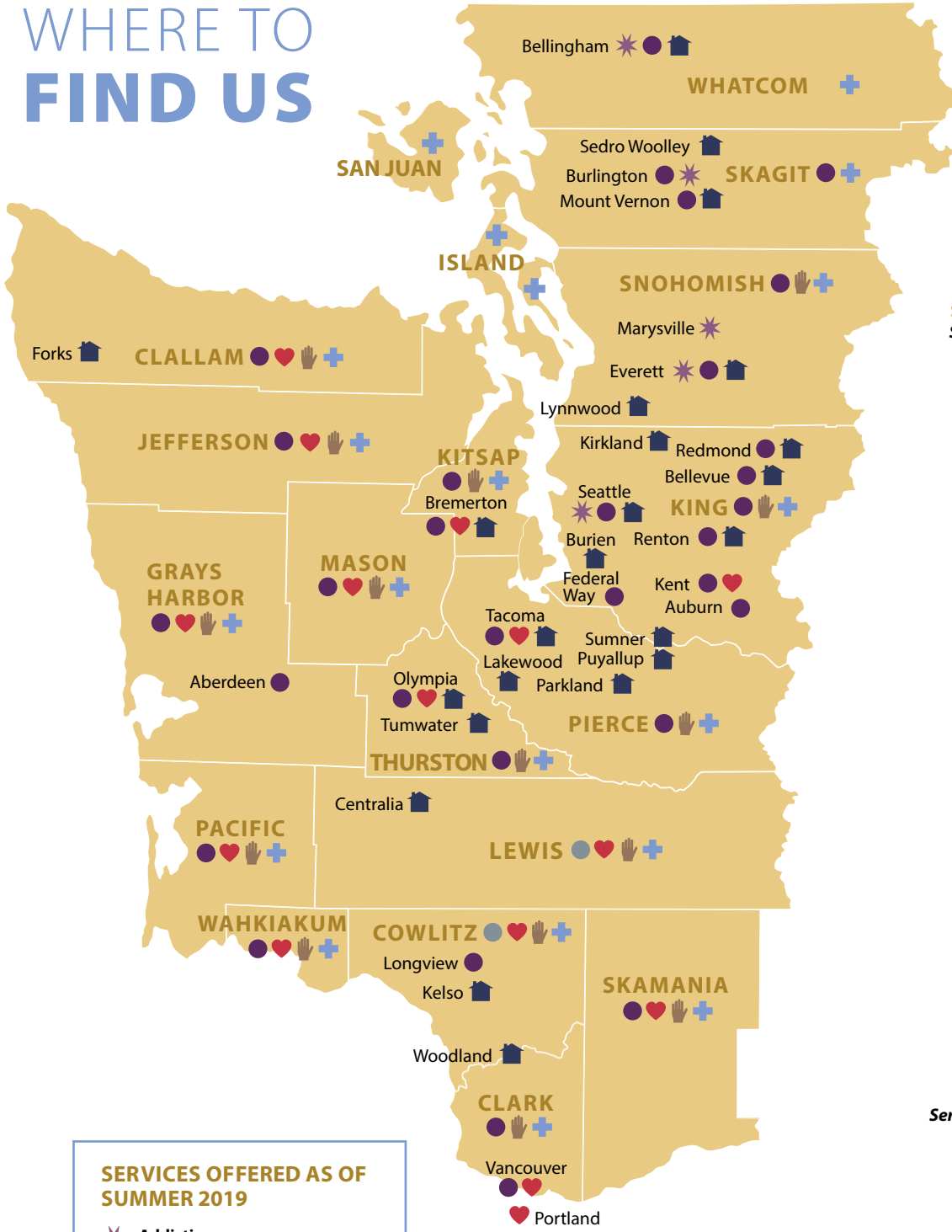
