### SHELTERS AND HOMELESS SERVICES

#### HOMELESS SERVICES

##### NATIVITY HOUSE

**253-502-1915**

Serves men and women experiencing homelessness. The Day Shelter offers basic needs like warm meals and clothing, as well as mental health support, substance use disorder assessments and referrals to housing. The Overnight Shelter has 167 emergency beds for single men and women. Together, they operate 24/7/365 to help our neighbors become more stable and move toward housing.

##### FAMILY HOUSING NETWORK

**253-471-5340**

Offers a continuum of services that help families experiencing homelessness obtain permanent housing. The target populations are families with children and military veteran households. Case managers work with families to offer a variety of housing solutions including diversion, rapid rehousing and permanent supportive housing. New this year is the Family Day Center, a safe refuge with basic services such as showers, laundry, kitchen facilities, computer stations and same day Coordinated Entry assessments.

##### TAHOMA INDIAN CENTER

Meets the basic needs of low-income and homeless Urban Native Peoples in a safe, warm, drug- and alcohol-free environment.
