SHELTERS AND HOMELESS SERVICES

BERTHA'S PLACE

360-968-8955

Bertha's Place is a 62 unit, 24/7 low-barrier non-congregate shelter for people experiencing homelessness. All residents (1/3 single women, 1/3 couples with a female head of household, and 1/3 people over 55) work with staff towards regaining permanent housing.

BERTHA'S PLACE TOO

Bertha's Place Too is a 32 unit, 24/7 low-barrier non-congregate shelter for people experiencing homelessness. All residents (1/3 single women, 1/3 couples with a female head of household, and 1/3 people over 55) work with staff towards regaining permanent housing.

PROGRAMS IN FAMILY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SYSTEM

CRISIS STABILIZATION SERVICES FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES

800-626-8137

Brief services are designed to achieve stabilization with families in crisis in order to avoid unnecessary psychiatric hospitalizations. During the 14-day crisis stabilization period, CCS provides an array of in-home support services including crisis response, safety/crisis assessment and treatment services. Through a wraparound framework, extended family, community and natural resources are combined with more traditional mental health services to bring about

safety, stabilization, and community integration. Services are available 24/7. Referrals are through Crisis Connections. Services available in Clark County.

HEALTH HOMES

360-567-2211

Health Homes staff coordinate care for high risk children, youth as identified by a PRISM score of 1.5 or higher. Health Homes is a voluntary service option. As part of this service, CCS Care Coordinators will assist families with navigating and integrating their health care and social service needs, improve their overall health and wellbeing, and manage their chronic conditions. Care coordinators will focus on integrating the following services: Medical, Mental/Behavioral Health, Long Term Services and Supports and Community/Social Support Referrals. MOBILE CRISIS SERVICES FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES

Brief crisis resolution for all youth (under 18 years). Clinician meets the youth and family, assesses the immediate risk, and engages the youth and family in a process of crisis resolution and individualized safety planning. An agreed upon action plan is created with the family, and linkages to other helpful supports and services are initiated. Intervention typically runs less than 72 hours. Referrals are through Crisis Connections. Services available in Clark County.

PEDIATRIC INTEGRATED CARE

CCS collaborates with the Child and Adolescent Clinic to provide an integrated approach to physical and behavioral health care. As Child and Adolescent Clinic physicians assess a behavioral health need, a warm hand off is made to a CCS clinician based at the clinic. Services available in Cowlitz County.

WISe (WRAPAROUND WITH INTENSIVE SERVICES)

WISe, is an approach to helping Medicaid-eligible children, youth, and their families with intensive mental health care. Services are available in home and community settings and offer a system of care based on the individualized need of the child or youth. WISe is a voluntary service that takes a team approach to support you and your family in meeting your goals. Services available in Clark, Cowlitz and Skamania Counties.

SENIORS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

HOME CARE FOR ELDERLY AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES 800-219-0335

Home Care provides non-medical assistance to aging persons and those with disabilities living in their homes. Home Care Aides provide a range of services from housework, grocery shopping, and laundry to personal care such as dressing, bathing, and helping transfer from the bed. Care may be just a few hours a day, or around the clock. Bilingual staff available in Russian, Spanish, Polish, and Vietnamese.

CAREGIVER TRAINING 360-417-5420

The Caregiver Training Program provides Basic Training and ongoing Continuing Education for Home Care Aides throughout Washington. Nurse Delegation and Advanced Training are also provided. Training is provided by a team of state-approved instructors in multiple languages, including English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Russian and Korean.

There is no cost for the program, but donations are greatly appreciated and helps keep this program going.
