HOUSING AND HOMELESS SERVICES

HOUSING SNOHOMISH

Programs and services that support homeless individuals and families, including coordinated entry, short term financial assistance (rapid rehousing), utility assistance, chemical dependency, and mental health services, HIV/AIDS supportive services, veterans programs, permanent supportive housing, and help with employment, healthcare and education.

FAMILY AND YOUTH SERVICES

CCS RECOVERY CENTERS

CCS Recovery Centers provide a full continuum of outpatient addiction recovery services in Snohomish County for youth and adults and their families. Services are provided in both Everett and Marysville.

COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

425-257-1621

CCS provides community mental health services to Medicaid eligible children and their families. After an initial assessment and determination of need for ongoing help, core mental health services are available at CCS including individual and/or family counseling/therapy, medication evaluation/management and coordination with primary care physicians, and case management.

WISE (WRAPAROUND WITH INTENSIVE SERVICES)

425-257-1621

Services are provided to Medicaid-eligible children and their families with high mental health and other complex needs, using a team-based Wraparound approach.

LAYETTE SERVICES

425-257-2111

Provides low-income families with basic newborn necessities. Layettes include bottles, socks, one outfit, sleepers, a stuffed animal and a baby blanket.

SENIORS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

HOME CARE FOR ELDERS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

800-219-0335

Home Care provides non-medical assistance to aging persons and those with disabilities living in their homes. Home Care Aides provide a range of services from housework, grocery shopping, and laundry to personal care such as dressing, bathing, and helping transfer from the bed. Care may be just a few hours a day, or around the clock. Bilingual staff available in Russian, Spanish, Polish, and Vietnamese.

CAREGIVER TRAINING

360-417-5420

The Caregiver Training Program provides Basic Training and ongoing Continuing Education for Home Care Aides throughout Washington. Nurse Delegation and Advanced Training are also provided. Training is provided by a team of state-approved instructors in multiple languages, including English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Russian and Korean.

RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (RSVP)

425-374-6311

Volunteers 55 years or older are placed at "work stations" throughout Snohomish County, according to the type of volunteer work they enjoy and skill sets they have to share, for example hospitals, food banks, and Senior Centers.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES

Volunteers help low-income older adults and adults with disabilities remain living independent in their own homes by assisting with basic needs such as transportation, shopping, housework, and yard care.

VOLUNTEER TRANSPORTATION

Provides necessary transportation for low-income elders and adults with disabilities to access medical appointments and other essential errands, such as grocery shopping. Also provides transportation to maintain social connections.

VETERANS SERVICES



DISABLED VETERANS TRANSPORTATION

Provides door-to-door services for disabled veterans living in underserved areas of Snohomish County to access medical appointments and other essential errands.

SEBASTIAN PLACE

With 20 units of permanent supportive housing, Sebastian Place provides housing for chronically homeless and vulnerable Veterans that seek a supportive community.
