HOPE HOUSE

CCS Recovery Center provides a full continuum of outpatient addiction recovery services in Whatcom County for youth and adults and their families.



COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

CCS provides community mental health services to Medicaid eligible children and their families. After an initial assessment and determination of need for ongoing help, core mental health services are available at CCS include individual and/or family counseling/therapy, medication evaluation/management and coordination with primary care physicians, and case management.

WISe (WRAPAROUND WITH INTENSIVE SERVICES)

WISe is an intensive outpatient mental health program. WISe provides home and community-based wraparound services for Medicaid-eligible youth (up to 20 years old) with multiple and complex needs, and their families.

HOME CARE FOR ELDERLY AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Home Care provides non-medical assistance to aging persons and those with disabilities living in their homes. Home Care Aides provide a range of services from housework, grocery shopping, and laundry to personal care such as dressing, bathing, and helping transfer from the bed. Care may be just a few hours a day, or around the clock. Bilingual staff available in Russian, Spanish, Polish, and Vietnamese.

CAREGIVER TRAINING

The Caregiver Training Program provides Basic Training and ongoing Continuing Education for Home Care Aides throughout Washington. Nurse Delegation and Advanced Training are also provided. Training is provided by a team of state-approved instructors in multiple languages, including English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Russian and Korean.
