

Enrolling Your Scholar with YTP

Q: How do I qualify and how do I enroll?

A: All youth enrolled with YTP must either have a section 8 voucher or be currently living on a property of Seattle Housing authority (SHA). YTP serves scholars in 1st-12th grade during our School-Year Session, and scholars in 1st-8th grade during our Summer Session.

To enquire about enrollment, send an email to the Center Supervisor for the location you are interested in your child attending.

Q: When can my child start attending YTP tutor sessions?

A: Many of our centers have waitlists, and waitlist times vary for each center. To check for an updated status on your center waitlist, please contact a Center Supervisor.

Q: What do YTP sessions typically consist of during the school year?

A: YTP's mission and vision centers on educational support and enrichment, individualized for each scholar. Scholars usually attend twice a week for one hour.

The typical tutoring session during the academic year will consist of homework help, reading exercises, and various skill building activities. YTP has many activities available at our centers to utilize during sessions with your scholar.

Volunteering with YTP

Q: What steps are required for me to start tutoring with YTP?

A: 1.) Fill out initial online application [here](#), and submit a copy of a valid photo ID to volunteerytp@ccsww.org

2.) Attend an online volunteer orientation

3.) Ensure YTP receives a response from 3 references listed in your online application

4.) Complete online paperwork

5.) Complete Seattle Tutoring Coalition Tutor Volunteer Training and Anti-Racism Training, and pass online backgrounds check run by YTP

6.) Respond to email from volunteerytp@ccsww.org confirming your center and your time to start tutoring.

Q: Does YTP have a waitlist for tutoring?

A: YTP does not have a waitlist for tutoring. YTP has waitlists for scholars who need tutors and YTP has a constant need for volunteer tutors! Tutors are needed at all centers, but centers in South and West Seattle have the greatest need.

Q: Does volunteering with YTP count for service-learning hours? What about court-ordered service?

A: YTP does accept volunteers fulfilling service learning hours. YTP does not accept volunteers fulfilling court-ordered service.
