Monica's Village Place I is 51 units of new, affordable housing in Seattle's Historic Central Area, at the intersection of 23rd Avenue South and South Main Streets, consisting of one, two, and three bedroom apartments and townhomes. All units are affordable to families making 30% to 50% of the area median household income with special designations for homeless families. The building is oriented around a central courtyard containing a play area for children and a healing/reflection garden.
