HOPE HOUSE VOLUNTEER OPENINGS

Hope House is a Catholic, non-profit located right next door to Assumption Church, we serve clothing, hygiene items, and household items to homeless and low-income families in Whatcom County. We have a few volunteer positions open and would love to find people to fill them.

Items Organizer
We receive donations of blankets, sheets, and towels and need someone who can come in once or twice a week and work on sizing these items, folding, and getting them placed in their correct shelves. This job can be done during our open hours or after we are closed and can mostly be done sitting down if needed.

Cleaning
We need volunteers who are available to come by Hope House once or twice a week after we close to sweep and mop the floors, wipe down surfaces, take out the trash, and restock the bathrooms.

Substitutes
We need people who are interested in being on a "substitute" list to fill in for our regular weekly volunteers when they have to miss a shift. If you have been wanting to volunteer with Hope House without committing to a weekly schedule, this is the place for you! Your name and phone number would be added to a list and our regular volunteers would contact you if they need to miss a day of volunteering to see if you can fill in.
