A 50 unit, low barrier, harm reduction, enhanced shelter program for adults and couples without children that are experiencing homelessness. Located on Queen Anne side of Aurora Ave N.

- **Most needed items: large-sized jackets (men/women), utensils, hygiene supplies, laundry supplies**
- **Clothing:** gloves/mittens, jacket/coat/sweater (men/women), socks,
- **Food:** butter, coffee, creamer, mayonnaise
