MENTAL HEALTH AND RECOVERY SERVICES

Grays Harbor Adult Behavioral Health offers outpatient services to Medicaid enrollees with Molina, United, or Wellpoint healthcare insurance requesting individual and group therapy, peer services, housing supports, psychoeducation, mental health medication management/prescribing and life skills classes. Individuals are required to receive a mental health assessment from our MHP. We serve clients age 18 and up. No referral necessary.

WISE (WRAPAROUND WITH INTENSIVE SERVICES)

WISe is an approach to helping Medicaid-eligible children, youth, and their families with intensive mental health care. Services are available in-home and community settings and offer a system of care based on the individualized need of the child or youth. WISe is a voluntary service that takes a team approach to supporting clients and their families in meeting your goals.

CAREGIVER TRAINING

The Caregiver Training Program provides Basic Training and ongoing Continuing Education for Home Care Aides throughout Washington. Nurse Delegation and Advanced Training are included. Training is provided by a team of state-approved instructors in multiple languages, including English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Russian, and Korean.

HOME CARE FOR ELDERLY AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Home Care provides assistance to aging persons and those with disabilities to assist them living in their homes. Licensed Home Care Aides provide personal care such as dressing, bathing, toilet use, medication management, personal hygiene, vital signs, assistance with walking, and helping transfer from the bed. Care may be just a few hours a day, or around the clock. Bilingual staff available in Russian, Spanish, and Vietnamese.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES
