BABY LAYETTE SERVICES

Provides low-income families a gift bag with basic newborn necessities, including baby bottles, socks, bibs, one outfit, baby hat, sleepers, a stuffed animal, a baby blanket, as well as, baby's first diapers & wipes.

CHILDREN'S COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

CCS provides community mental health services to Medicaid eligible children and their families. After an initial assessment and determination of need for ongoing help, core mental health services are available at CCS including individual and/or family counseling/therapy, medication evaluation/management and coordination with primary care physicians, and case management.

CCS Recovery Centers provide a full continuum of outpatient addiction recovery services in Snohomish County for youth, adults, and their families.

WISE (WRAPAROUND WITH INTENSIVE SERVICES)

Services are provided to Medicaid-eligible children and their families with high mental health and other complex needs, using a team-based Wraparound approach.

SENIORS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

CAREGIVER TRAINING

The Caregiver Training Program provides Basic Training and ongoing Continuing Education for Home Care Aides throughout Washington. Nurse Delegation and Advanced Training are included. Training is provided by a team of state-approved instructors in multiple languages, including English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Russian, and Korean.

HOME CARE FOR ELDERS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Home Care provides assistance to aging persons and those with disabilities to assist them living in their homes. Licensed Home Care Aides provide personal care such as dressing, bathing, toilet use, medication management, personal hygiene, vital signs, assistance with walking, and helping transfer from the bed. Care may be just a few hours a day, or around the clock. Bilingual staff available in Russian, Spanish, and Vietnamese.

RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

Volunteers 55 years or older are placed at "work stations" throughout Snohomish County, according to the type of volunteer work they enjoy and skill sets they have to share, for example hospitals, food banks, and Senior Centers.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES
