## MENTAL HEALTH AND RECOVERY SERVICES

### CCS RECOVERY CENTERS

CCS Recovery Centers provide a full continuum of outpatient addiction recovery services in Whatcom County for youth and adults.

### CHILDREN'S COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

CCS provides community mental health services to Medicaid eligible children and their families. After an initial assessment and determination of need for ongoing help, core mental health services are available at CCS include individual and/or family counseling/therapy, medication evaluation/management and coordination with primary care physicians, and case management.

### WISE (WRAPAROUND WITH INTENSIVE SERVICES)

WiSe is an intensive outpatient mental health program. WiSe provides home and community-based wraparound services for Medicaid-eligible youth (up to 20 years old) with multiple and complex needs, and their families.

## SENIORS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

### CAREGIVER TRAINING

The Caregiver Training Program provides Basic Training and ongoing Continuing Education for Home Care Aides throughout Washington. Nurse Delegation and Advanced Training are included. Training is provided by a team of state-approved instructors in multiple languages, including English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Russian, and Korean.

### HOME CARE FOR ELDERS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Home Care provides assistance to aging persons and those with disabilities to assist them living in their homes. Licensed Home Care Aides provide personal care such as dressing, bathing, toilet use, medication management, personal hygiene, vital signs, assistance with walking, and helping transfer from the bed. Care may be just a few hours a day, or around the clock. Bilingual staff available in Russian, Spanish, and Vietnamese.
